

Crochet pattern Crown

UK crochet terms



Outside of crown:

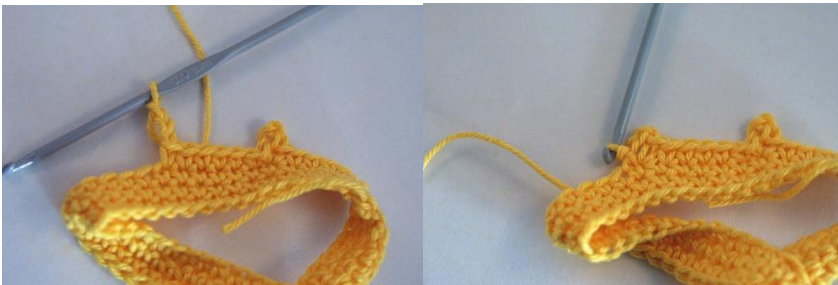
1. Make a chain of 48 chainstitches, connect them into a circle with a slipstitch. (make sure the chain doesn't twist!)



2. Crochet 3 rounds of 48 double crochets, closing each round with a slipstitch and a chainstitch. (3 x 48)



3. Crochet 5 double crochets, 3 chainstitches, and secure with slipstitch in the same stitch (picot)



4. 6 double crochets, 3 chainstitches, and secure with slipstitch in the same stitch (picot)
5. Repeat step 4 six times, to a total of 8 picots. Close round with 1 double crochet.

6. Now we will proceed to the first crown part:
7. 3 double crochets, 1 chainstitch (turn after every chainstitch) (3)
8. 3 rounds of 3 double crochets (3), end every round with a chainstitch
9. 1 double crochet, 2 double crochets in the same stitch, 1 double crochet (4), chainstitch.
10. 2 rows of 4 double crochets, end every round with a chainstitch
11. 1 double crochet, 2 double crochets in one stitch, 2 double crochet (5), chainstitch.
12. 1 round of 5 double crochets, chainstitch
13. 1 double crochet, hook 2 double crochets together, 2 double crochets (4), chainstitch
14. 2 rows of 4 double crochets, end every round with a chainstitch
15. 1 double crochet, hook 2 double crochets together, 1 double crochet (3), chainstitch
16. 3 rows of 3 double crochets (3), end every round with a chainstitch
17. 1 double crochet, hook 2 double crochets together (2) chainstitch
18. 2 rows of 2 double crochets, end every round with a chainstitch, end.



Crochet 7 more crown parts (indicated in green): between every picot there are 5 stitches, the middle 3 stitches are used for the crown parts: You crochet 3 double crochets (number 7 in green) between two picots en crochet your way up.



De underside of the crown part is decorated with the crab stitch.



Uppermost cap:

1. Magic loop, 4 double crochets (4)
2. 4 double crochets (4)
3. Double each stitch (8)
4. 8 double crochets
5. Double each second stitch (12)
6. Double each third stitch (16), close with slipstitch.

The uppermost cap now has 16 stitches, and so do the 8 crown parts (8x2 stitches). Now you can crochet or sew the cap and crown parts together.



The crown can be decorated with beads. I used "invisible" nylon thread to sew the beads to the crown.



The inside part of the crown:

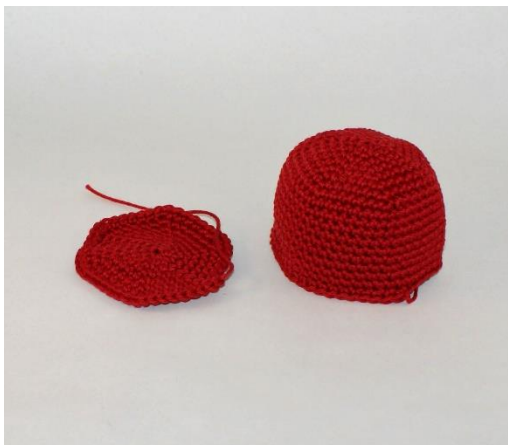
The inside part of the crown is made of two parts that are sewn together. You could make stripes in the inside part if you like.

Part 1:

1. Magic loop, 6 double crochets (6)
2. Double each stitch (12)
3. Double each second stitch (18)
4. Double each third stitch (24)

5. Double each fourth stitch (30)
6. Double each fifth stitch (36)
7. Double each sixth stitch (42)
8. Double each seventh stitch (48)
9. 10 rounds of 48 double crochets (10 x 48)

Part 2 is the same as part 1, only crochet rounds 1-8.



If you want to change colors you could crochet rounds 1-8 in one color (red), and of the last 10 rounds: 4 rounds in the second color (white) and 6 rounds in a third color (blue).



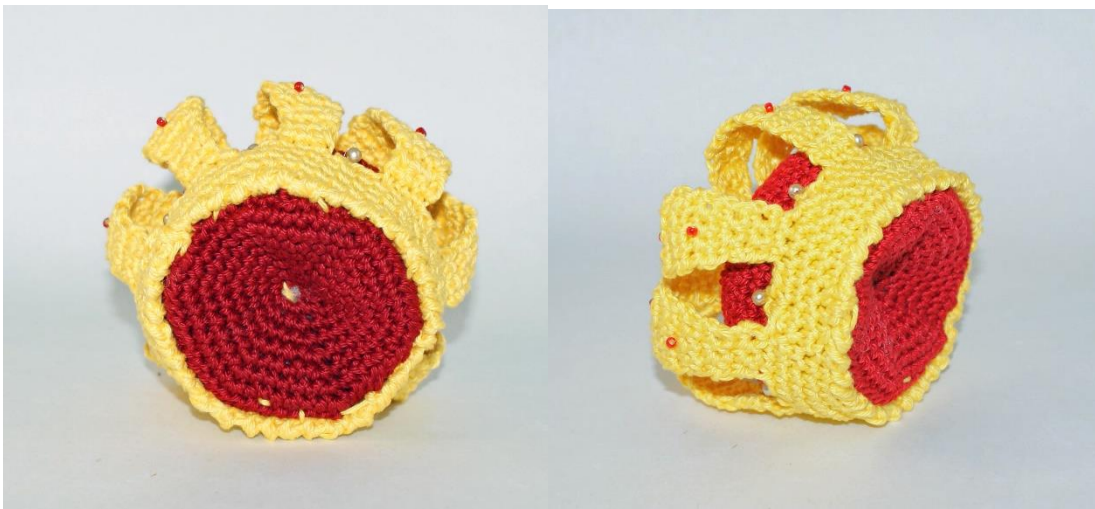
Sew the two parts together, fill the shape lightly.



Put the half sphere into the crown part.



Sew the uppermost cap tightly through the sphere in place, so that the crown gets its shape.



Also sew the picots to the inside sphere to make them stand upright. You could give the crown more sturdiness with starch.
